POST OFFICE CLOSURES IN EALING

Royal Mail announced yesterday the further closure of 8 Post Offices in Ealing.

Conservatives have been quick to condemn these proposals and have vowed to use the 6 week consultation period to fight them all the way.

Richard Barnes, local London Assembly member said 'The Post Office may think that London can absorb closures more readily than rural areas, but try telling that to mothers with young children, the elderly, the disabled and other vulnerable groups.'
